
### Additional Report A: Recidivism Analysis on Former Drug Court Participants

The Warren County Drug Court graduated its first program participant in September of 2005. Since that time, a total of 42 program participants have successfully completed the program. The Drug Court program offers tangible and intangible improvements in the quality of life of participants who were successful in completing the program. One of those tangible factors can be illustrated by their lack of criminal activity. Of the 42 graduates since the Drug Court's inception, 74% remained successful in their efforts to stay out of legal trouble while 26% experienced a recurrence of criminal behavior.

### Positive Outcomes in Quality of Life

Out of 42 graduates from the Drug Court program since its inception in 2005, 26% reverted to criminal activity while 74% successfully remained out of legal trouble.



Drug Court graduates were crossed by both a County check and a check through the FBI's National Crime Information Center.

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### Reduction in Offending Rates

Out of 11 graduates from the Drug Court program who reverted to criminal activity, offenses were most prevalent during the first year after graduation. Total charges among re-offenders were still reduced by 58% following the program.
