1. Grinding of the wood chips located at: 169 Paws Trail, McMinnville, TN 37110 (Next to Warren County Animal Control)
2. Hauling of the ground wood chips approximately 1 ½ miles to a specific location on Belmont Drive to be determined by Warren County Government.
3. Contractor will be responsible for all cleanup after completion of project
4. Contractor must coordinate work schedules with Warren County Executive Herschel Wells, Sr.
5. Workman's Comp must meet minimum state requirements.
6. Liability insurance must meet minimum state requirements.
7. Any bid over \$25,000 requires a Tennessee State Contractors License.
8. Project must be completed by August 15, 2015.
9. Payment to be made upon satisfactory completion of project.
