

INVITATION TO BIDDERS

Sealed bids, subject to the conditions contained herein, will be accepted by the Warren County Financial Management Committee at the Warren County Administrative Building, Office of the Finance Director, 201 Locust Street, Suite 2, McMinnville, Tennessee, 37110 up to but no later than 10:00 A. M. Central Time on Monday, April 25, 2016 and then publicly opened and read for the following Project for the Warren County Memorial Airport (TAD Project Number: 89-555-0760-04):

1. Clear and Remove all Vegetation, Structures, and Debris on approximately Six and One-Half (6 ½) Acres located on Warren County Memorial Airport property. The property and project will be identified at the pre-bid meeting.
2. Site to be Disked
3. Site to be Sown with Fescue-20 lbs. per acre
4. Site to be Sown with Perennial Rye Grass-30 lbs. per acre
5. Site to be Fertilized with 15-15-15 Fertilizer – 30 lbs. per acre

A MANDATORY PRE-BID MEETING will be held on Monday, April 11, 2016 at 10:30 A.M. CT at the Warren County Memorial Airport Terminal, 4187 Nashville Highway, McMinnville, Tennessee, 37110. More information and specifications for the project will be identified at this meeting. All interested parties must attend the pre-bid meeting in order to be eligible to submit a bid for consideration.

Award of the bid will be dependent upon availability of funding and subject to budget limitations. The right is reserved as the interest of Warren County, Tennessee may require to accept or reject any or all bids received, to accept or reject any item thereon, to waive any informalities in bidding, and/or to abandon or postpone this project without any obligation to bidders. In case of tie bids, Warren County, Tennessee reserves the right to negotiate with bidders.
