Sealed bids, subject to the conditions contained herein, will be accepted by the Warren County Financial Management Committee at the Office of the Department of Finance, 201 Locust Street, Suite 2, McMinnville, Tennessee, 37110 up to but no later than 3:00 P.M. Central Time on Thursday, October 27, 2016 and then publicly opened and read for Striping, Guardrails, Road Oil, Aluminized Type 2 Corrugated Steel Pipe, Aluminized Type 2 Ultra Flo Steel Pipe, HDPE Smooth Interior Corrugated Pipe, Galvanized Corrugated Steel Pipe, Bituminous Coated Corrugated Metal Pipe ½ Coated, Class 3 Reinforced Elliptical Concrete Pipe, Class 3 Reinforced Concrete Pipe, Concrete Box Culverts, Hot Mix – Rap (Millings) Tack Coat Included, Hot Mix – Picked up at Plant, Hot Mix – Tack Coat Included, High Performance Cold Mix – Picked up at Plant, Crushed Stone – Delivered, Crushed Stone – F.O.B.
