CT beginning at the Warren County Administrative Office Building, Finance Department Conference Room, 201 Locust Street, McMinnville, TN 37110 to discuss specifications and scope of work for the proposal. All buildings to be included under the HVAC Planned Preventative Maintenance Strategy Program are identified below and will be visited during the pre-bid meeting for clarification of bid specifications and scope of work. Bidders must attend the mandatory pre-bid meeting in order to be eligible to submit a bid for consideration.
